School Closings: With the winter weather now upon us here is a reminder about school closing procedures.

There are times when it is necessary to close school because of adverse weather conditions. Parents always have the option of keeping their children at home or picking them up early from school when, in their judgement, the weather and/or road conditions dictate.

If Zeeland Public Schools cancel school for the day or announce a 2- hour delay due to weather conditions, Redeemer Christian School will do likewise. In the event that RCS needs to delay or close school for any reason, parents and teachers will be notified first by text message, and then the notification will be posted to WOODTV. The text will come from (833) 943-4607.

In all situations, Redeemer Christian School will make the decision to close school as early as possible, sometimes the night before school, but frequently early in the morning of a school day.
